

From the Pastor's Desk

According to Vatican II's Lumen Gentium, "For continual increase of the people of God and shepherding them, Christ, whom the Father has sanctified and sent into the world, through his apostles has made their successors, the bishops, sharers in his consecration and mission for the good of the church. They in turn have lawfully handed on to different individuals in the church in varying degrees a participation in this divine ministry. Therefore Priests, by virtue of the sacramental order in the image of Christ the eternal High priest, are consecrated to preach the gospel, to shepherd the faithful and to celebrate divine worship as true priests of the New Testament" (Nos, 51, 52, 54). Hence, the book of Hebrews 5:1 states, "every high priest is chosen from among men and ordained for men in things pertaining to God, that he may offer both gifts and sacrifices for sin." This bold step is what Fr. Redmond made a few years ago.

On this note, on behalf of our Cluster Parishes, I would like to extend a heartfelt and warm congratulations to Rev. Fr. Nicholas E. Redmond on his fifth anniversary (June 2018) into the Priesthood in the Holy Roman Catholic Church.
